Stages of Psychometric Measure Development: The example ...

psychometric requirement for measurement adequacy and is the first step in construct validation of a new measure (Schriesheim, Powers, Scandura, Gardiner, & Lankau, 1993) Content validity must be built into the measure through the development of items As suggested by Schriesheim et al (1993), content adequacy will be assessed
